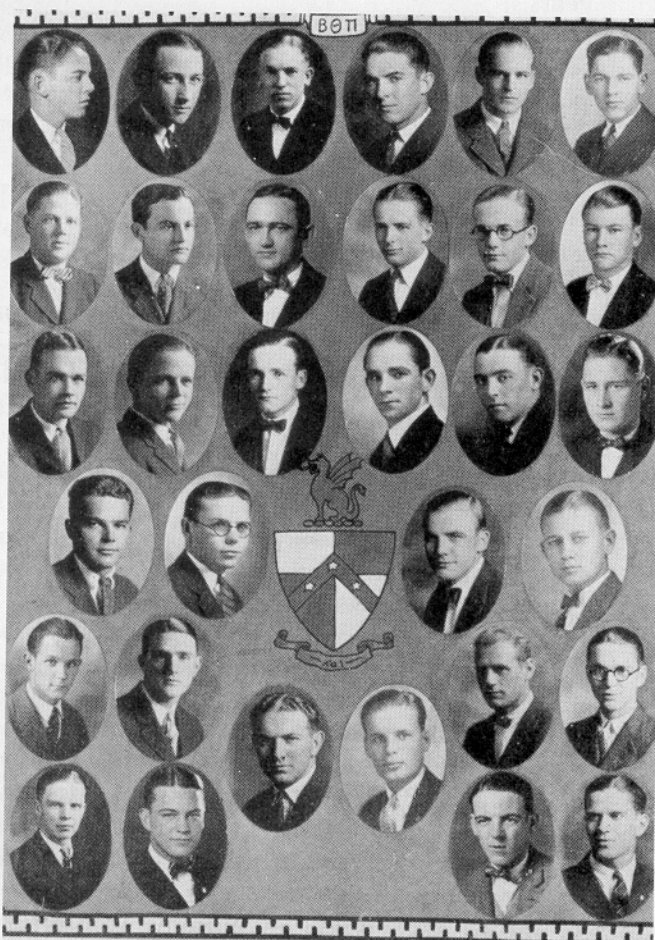

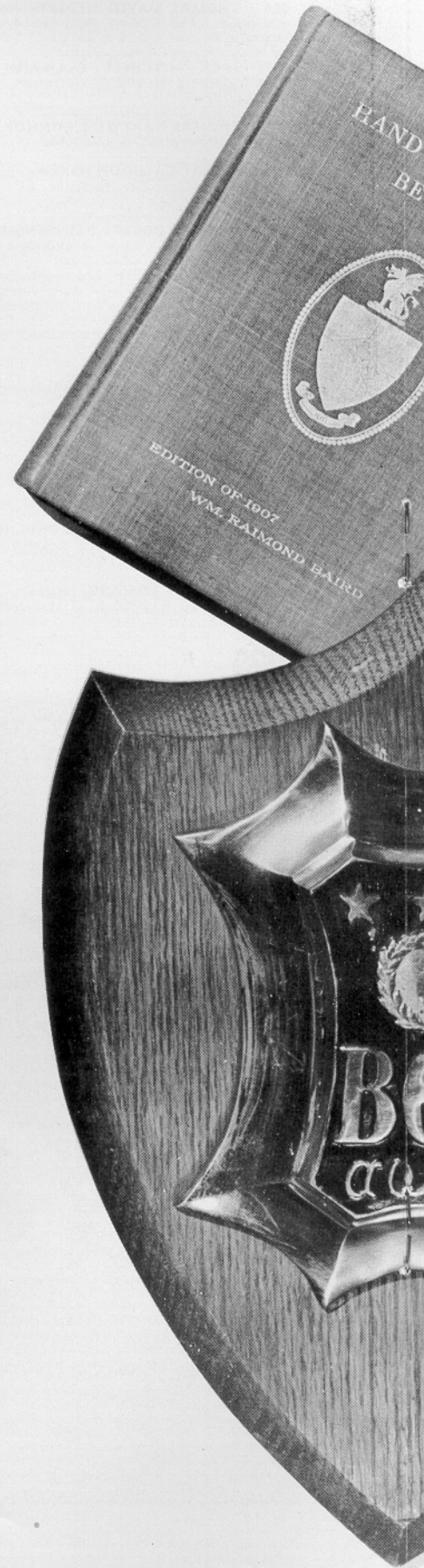

Boyd, a Beta from Wooster, served as the first president of the University of Oklahoma (1892-1908). During his term of office he was instrumental in the founding of the Beta chapter at OU.

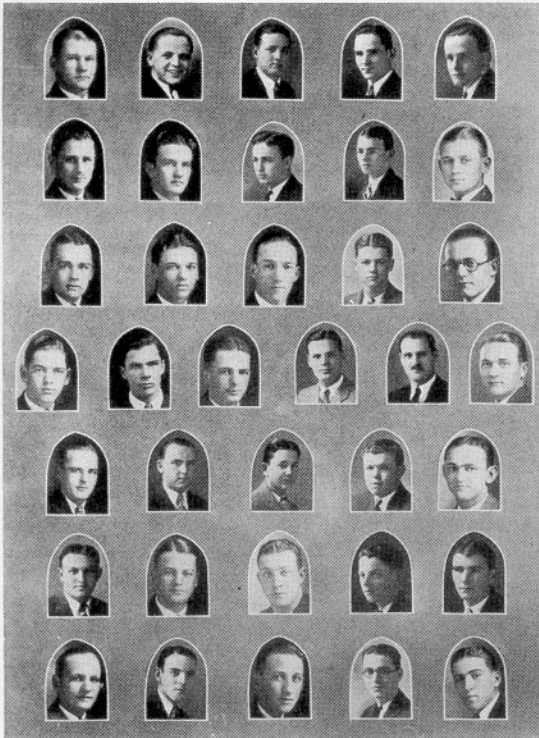
Editor's Note: This list by no means includes all the famous Beta athletes. But is a representative sample taken hastily from the records of several classes.
