A Scandals sweep highlighted the year for the members of Beta Theta Pi.

The fraternity, combined with the women of Chi Omega, captured eight of the nine group awards given at the annual Scandals production in mid-April. In addition, sophomore member Don Andrews was voted best male performer.

Their act followed the adventures of two OU students who were tired

of their own university and wanted to leave. The two were befriended by a student of Paris University named Pierre Pan, and his Mr. T-like assistant, Tinkerbell. After seeing the highlights of P.U., the two convinced their French friends to come to OU.

With their three song and dance numbers, the group won awards for Best Act in Show, Outstanding Music, Outstanding Choreography, Outstanding Script,

Originality, Showmanship, Best Costume and Best Backdrop Design.

Member Steve Rahhal, one of two assistant directors for the 41st Scandals production, said the awards were special because they were able to see "the months of hard work and time investment pay off."

"The excitement and anticipation provided an event that the entire house could truly rally behind," he said.

Earlier in the year, the

fraternity held their annual Beta Barn Dance, which has been rated by *Playboy* as one of the top fraternity parties in the nation.

Several Betas excelled on campus. Ken Feagins, Rahhal and Jeff Roberts were named to the Top Ten Greek Men, while Zach Allen and Scott Rahhal were named as Top Ten Sophomores.

In addition, five members were named to Gamma Gamma and Mortar Board, five were

selected as Big Men on Campus and two received Leitseizer medals. During the year, six of the fraternity's brothers were admitted to medical school, six to law school, two to dental school and three to graduate school for business.

The fraternity established a new scholarship fund and an alumni newsletter during the year, and their chapter room was renovated.



BARNDANCE BANDITS. Betas gather for their biggest event of the year, the Barn-dance, which is held every year in November.


